\$5,000 provides in-school snacks, meals for weekends, and food to sustain over holiday breaks for students and families at risk of food insecurity at one school for a full year. \$2,500 helps secure a new school's partnership and can provide 100 new coats to keep students warm during the cold winter months.

\$1,000 enables a school to provide 50 fresh produce boxes before winter break, ensuring that students have access to fresh, healthy foods when schools are closed.

\$500 supplies deodorant and shampoo for 250 students
