

ABOUT THE NETWORK

Your sponsorship makes a difference. Thank you!

\$25,000 provides the Network infrastructure and funding for a Room of Support in a school, with supplies of food, clothing, school supplies and personal care items for students in need for a full year.

\$15,000 provides a full year of critical support, including food, clothing, and school supplies, for students at a small to mid-size school.

\$10,000 supports the needs of students at a small or mid-size school- food, clothing, school supplies, and more - for a full year!

\$5,000 supplies weekend bags and meals to support students and families facing food insecurity at one school—covering every holiday break for an entire year.

\$2,500 can provide 100 new coats to keep students warm during the cold winter months.

\$1,000 enables a school to provide 45 fresh produce boxes before winter break, ensuring that students have access to fresh, healthy foods when schools are closed.

\$500 supplies deodorant or shampoo for 250 students

\$250 could buy a toothbrush or toothpaste for 125 students.
